

**A Resolution Adopting the Mora Arts & Cultural Compound
Cultural Plan 2018-2022**

WHEREAS, the Mora Valley is culturally rich in language, Hispanic arts, contemporary arts, regional cuisine and healing traditions; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners entered into a Cultural Plan Grant Agreement with New Mexico MainStreet under Grant #: 16-419-150231-1602; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Arts and Cultural District Program provided valuable funding, technical assistance and training to the Mora Arts & Cultural Compound; and

WHEREAS, the Mora County Cultural Plan has been developed in accordance with desires and needs of county residents as expressed through public input meetings, and community and artist surveys; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Plan is intended to promote community development, the arts, tourism, cultural identity and a robust creative economy; and

WHEREAS, the policies of the 2018 Cultural Plan shall serve as general guidelines for decisions making and development of County regulations affecting a creative economy and cultural affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County of Commissioners of Mora County has authority to adopt a cultural plan for development for creative economy, tourism, community identity, cultural heritage and youth and community development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mora County Commission hereby adopts the 2018-2022 Mora Cultural Plan; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cultural Plan may only be amended by resolution of the Mora County Commission.




