RESOLUTION NO. 2022-017
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING MORA COUNTY'S
SOLID WASTE FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, Mora County owns and operates solid waste facilities within its boundaries which are overseen by the Solid Waste Department; and

WHEREAS, properly operating the Mora County Solid Waste Department relies on fees which occasionally need to be adjusted to fund and sustain the department; and


WHEREAS, the costs of owning and operating the solid waste facilities have increased and the fee schedule has not been adjusted for at least seven years; and

WHEREAS, the disposal rates need to increase to cover the increase in costs and fund the infrastructure of the solid waste facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board has approved amended Mora County Ordinance No. 2015-2, Section 13, authorizing solid waste fees to be set and amended from time to time by resolution of the Board;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MORA hereby adopts the solid waste fee schedule identified as Exhibit A to this Resolution and the rates will take effect in the April 2022 billing cycle recognizing that continued, sustainable solid waste operations affects public health and safety.





“EXHIBIT A” TO RESOLUTION NO. 2022- 017 :
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING MORA COUNTY’S
SOLID WASTE FEE SCHEDULE

This Exhibit memorializes the Solid Waste Fee Schedule adopted by the County Commission of Mora County on March 29, 2022, as follows:

- a. **Billing Cycle:** Solid waste billing shall assess the fees set forth herein on or about April 1 and October 1 of each year.
- b. **Rates:** The following rates apply for the solid waste management fee for the Mora Transfer Station, Ocate Collection Center and Watrous Collection Center:
 1. **Residential fee:** The solid waste management fee shall be five monthly payments of Ten Dollars and Thirty-three Cents per month (\$10.33 for 5 months) and a sixth monthly payment of Ten Dollars and Thirty-five Cents (\$10.35 for the 6th month) to equal Sixty-Two Dollars and Zero Cents (\$62.00) bi-annually for each residence located in the unincorporated area in Mora County.
 2. **Senior Citizen (Age 65 and older):** The solid waste management fee shall be five monthly payments of Eight Dollars and Thirty-three cents per month (\$8.33 for 5 months) and a sixth monthly payment of Eight Dollars and Thirty-Five Cents (\$8.35) for the 6th month to equal Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$50.00) bi-

annually for each residence occupied and/or owned by a Senior Citizen which is located in the unincorporated area of Mora County.

3. **Seasonal fee:** The solid waste management fee shall be five monthly payments of Six Dollars and Thirty-Three Cents (\$6.33 for 5 months) and a sixth monthly payment of Six Dollars and Thirty-Five Cents (\$6.35) for the sixth month, to equal Thirty-eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$38.00) bi-annually for each premises which is seasonally occupied and located in the unincorporated area of Mora County.
4. **Fees for Non-account holders and delinquent accounts** are assessed as follows:
 - i. \$3.00 per 15-gallon bag or smaller;
 - ii. \$6.00 per 30-gallon bag;
 - iii. \$9.00 per 45-gallon bag;
 - iv. \$20.00 per 55-gallon bag or 55-gallon barrel;
 - v. \$30.00 per truckload and \$40 per trailer load.
5. **Hauler's Weigh Fee:** \$10.00
6. **Un-tarped/Un-netted Load Fee:** \$15.00
7. **Tires:** Tires up to 15" are assessed \$4.00 each; tires 16" to 20" are assessed \$8.00 each; and tires over 20" are assessed \$16.00 each.
8. **Failure to weigh in/out fee:** \$10.00
9. **Failure to dispose used oil into oil tanks:** \$1.00 per gallon
10. **Mattresses:** \$10.00 each
11. **Furniture:** \$10.00 each

- c. **Multiple residences:** If there are multiple residents on a given property, the solid waste management fee shall be assessed on each residence.
- d. **Commercial Fee:** Commercial solid waste management fees shall be determined by a class or ton rating with those commercial premises generating a higher volume of solid waste receiving the highest rating. The following shall govern the solid waste management commercial fee which will be billed monthly.
 - 1. **Class A: \$30.00 per ton**
 - i. **This category includes:** Schools, churches, convenience stores, grocery stores, fish hatchery, highway departments, state parks, clinics, restaurants and cafés, liquor dispensers, retail outlets, hotels, motels, gas stations, utility companies, home health care businesses, wholesale outlets, auto part stores, petroleum distributors, auto repair shops, clothing stores, laundromats, ranch stores, weaving shops/stores, American Legion or VFW posts (without non-profit designations), cemeteries, colleges, theaters, museums, limited construction debris, branches cut down to size, and any other new organizations.
 - 2. **Class B: \$20.00 under one ton**
 - i. Any of the categories set forth under Class A disposing less than one ton.
 - 3. **Class C: \$15.00 per month**
 - i. Post offices and trailer parks
 - 4. **Class D: \$10.00 per month**
 - i. Barber shops, art galleries, credit unions, soil conservation offices, business offices, banks, non-profit organizations, and community centers.
