#### (2) Road/Solid Waste- Transfer Station Operator/Hauler/Laborer – Full-time Positions

##### **Position Summary**

Under general supervision of Road/Solid Waste Supervisor, serves as a heavy equipment operator and laborer in the maintenance and construction of County road projects including preparing, paving and patching roads and parking lots, cleaning ditches, removing and installing culverts and other roadway structures and clearing property; may supervise a small team of employees on a temporary basis. Assists residents in the use of the transfer station and the recycling program; inspects customer materials and directs them to the appropriate area; ensures that customers observe safe practices while on the site; maintains logs and records as required; performs routine grounds maintenance and landscaping. The Transfer Station Attendant collects, logs and balances fees received to ensure a compliant cash handling procedure. The Solid Waste Hauler performs a variety of working level semi-skilled and skilled duties related to the operation of solid waste transport truck for the transfer of solid waste from county transfer stations.

##### **Minimum Qualifications**

- Citizen or legal resident of the United States who has reached eighteen (18) years of age;
- High School Diploma or GED;
- Valid New Mexico Commercial Driver's License (CDL Class A);
- Pass a pre-employment drug test and background investigation;
- Perform manual labor;
- Perform in an outdoor setting
