RESOLUTION NO. 2023-023

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE LOCATION OF POLLING PLACES FOR ALL STATEWIDE ELECTIONS CONDUCTED IN 2023 THROUGH 2025 AND TO APPOINT THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION MEMBERS FOR MORA COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-2 (2019), in June of 2023 the Board of County Commissioners of Mora County shall designate by resolution the locations of election day polling places in the county for the conduct of any statewide election conducted in the calendar years of 2023 through 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners find that each polling place designated in this resolution complies with the provisions of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-7 (2019), titled polling place; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners find the voters of those precincts, which pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-4 (2023), are not consolidated for the purpose of creating Voter Convenience Center shall be permitted to option of voting in their home precinct on election day or in any Voting Convenience Center; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that those precincts designated as mail ballot election precincts meet the Qualification of NMSA 1978, Section 1-6-22.1(A) (2023), have fewer than one hundred (100) voters, and the nearest place for an adjoining precinct is more than twenty (20) miles driving distance from the boundary of the Mail Ballot Election Precinct; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that each polling place provides individuals with physical mobility access to at least one voting machine; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-4-34 (2023), the Board of County Commissioners shall at this meeting in June 2023 appoint of Board of Registration for the County who, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-4-37 (2019), shall serve a term of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Mora County designates the Election Day polling locations for any statewide election to be conducted in 2023 through 2025 as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby appoint the following three members for 5,000 or less voters, who meet the qualifications of Subsections B of NMSA 1978, Section 1-4-34 (2023), to serve as the Board of Registration for Mora County from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025:
