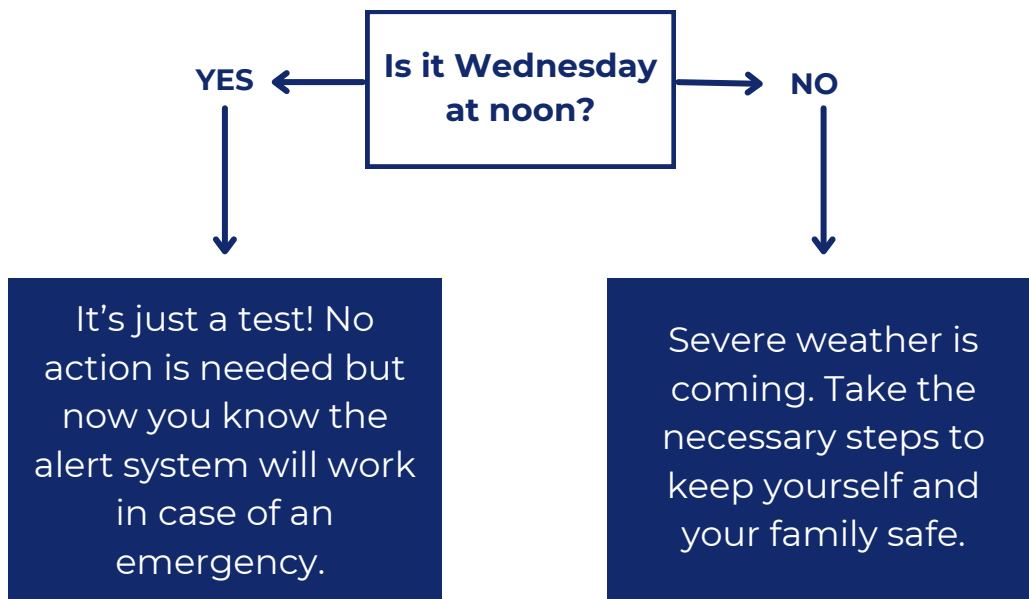


OUTDOOR EMERGENCY ALERT SIRENS

About the Sirens and How They Work

Outdoor emergency alert sirens have been placed on county property and are maintained by the New Mexico Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. They can be utilized by local public safety entities to alert residents of incoming severe weather, like flooding.

To ensure these sirens are functioning, DHSEM will conduct weekly tests. Residents can expect to hear the sirens every Wednesday at noon.

- **Avoid travel if possible.**
- **Stay indoors.**
- **In the event of flooding, get to higher ground.**
- **Turn around, don't drown! Never enter flood waters in a vehicle or on foot.**
